Big Idea

A mother's influence is one of the most powerful ways God shapes lives and builds faith.

Timothy 1:3-7

Some of the greatest impact in the world doesn't happen on stages - it happens in homes.

A Mother's Influence Begins With Genuine Faith

"I remember your genuine faith..."

Not perfect faith - just real faith that works in real time.

A Mother's Influence Is Passed Down Daily

“...that first filled your grandmother...and your mother...”

Grandma passed down to Mom and
Mom passed down to Timothy....

A Mother's Influence Shapes Future Generations

Timothy became the leader he was because of what
was poured into him by Grandma and Mom.

Sermon Questions

Icebreaker: What's one way someone's authentic faith influenced you when you were younger? (Use your mom if it applies).

1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. How does the concept of 'genuine faith' differ from 'perfect faith,' and why is this distinction important for mothers and all believers?
3. What are some practical ways we can demonstrate authentic faith in everyday life, especially when we're struggling? In our parenting or grandparenting?
4. Discuss the idea that "the little moments are really the big moments." How does this change the way we view ordinary days?
5. What are some specific 'little moments' in daily life that you believe are actually 'big moments' for shaping faith in the next generation?
6. How does the multi-generational faith journey from Lois to Eunice to Timothy challenge or encourage you about the legacy you are building?
7. What are some ways we can be intentional about passing down faith to the next generation (whether our own children, nieces/nephews, or spiritual children)?
8. Much of motherhood and spiritual influence happens behind the scenes. Why is it important to remember that "God sees every sacrifice, every prayer, every tear, and every act of love"?

Personal Challenge:

1. Reflect on your own "family tree" of faith. Who influenced you? Who are you influencing?
2. Journal about one way you've seen God work through your consistency, even in small things.
