Live for Jesus

Big Idea

I will live out my faith by serving and sharing.

Matthew 20:20-28, Luke 19:1-10

Matthew 20:20-28

The request reflects the height of arrogance and misunderstanding. They will have a privileged position, but it will be one of suffering, in keeping with Jesus' own mission.

Verse 28 – For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.

Jesus' own mission was self-giving, not self-serving, as he came to die for the sins of humanity.

Luke 19:10

For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.

Not only is he able to save, but he also takes initiative in seeking those who need to be saved since he is both a powerful and merciful Savior.

Study Questions

1. What stood out to me, challenged me, or encouraged me from Sunday's message/service?
2. What does the request in the Matthew verses tell you about James and John? Look at vs 24. What might the other disciples' response say about them?
3. What had Jesus just told the disciples in Matthew 20:17-19? How does Jesus try to connect His words in 17-19 to their request in vs. 21? In the kingdom of God, what makes someone great?
4. In Luke 18:18-30 a wealthy ruler asked Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus told him he must go sell all he had and give the money to the poor and then follow Him. The wealthy man went away sad. In what ways is the story of Zacchaeus different?
5. What can we learn about living for Jesus in both of these sections of verses?
