Big Idea

God can keep working through our lives
even after our part in the story is finished.

2 Kings 13:20-21

A Look Back

Elijah chooses Elisha from the back of the line.

What ditch do we need to dig?

If it matters to you, it matters to God.

Fear shrinks when faith sees God's unseen presence.

A Look Back Continued

We often see the enemy before we see God.

Mercy can accomplish what violence never could.

God knows how to do a lot with a little.

God's provision begins where our resources end.

Build it for God.

Today

Elisha was gone - but God wasn't done.

You never know how far your influence will reach.

You may never know the full impact of your faithfulness.

Our hope isn't in Elisha's bones - it's in Elisha's God.

But the miracles aren't really the point.

The God behind the miracles - that's the point.

Sermon Applications

Choose one or both of the following to put into practice this week.

1. Trace the Faithfulness

Write down the names of two or three people whose faithfulness shaped your faith. Spend time this week thanking God for them. If any of them are still living, consider reaching out to tell them what their investment meant to you.

2. Invest Intentionally

Identify one person in your life - a younger believer, a child, a coworker, a neighbor - and take one concrete step this week to invest in them spiritually. It does not have to be elaborate. A conversation, a text, an invitation, a prayer offered on their behalf.
