## Sermon Questions

Icebreaker: Share about a time when something you thought was stable or secure turned out not to be. What did you learn from that experience?

1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. The sermon defined faith as "a God-given ability that allows us to take God at His Word." How does this definition compare to how you've previously understood faith?
3. If someone examined your daily schedule, spending habits, and conversations, what would they conclude your life is built on?
4. The sermon noted that "sand looks fine until pressure comes." What are some "sand foundations" that look stable in our culture but won't hold up under real trials? (Examples might include success, comfort, reputation, financial security, etc.)
5. The wise builder prepares before the storm arrives. What are some practical ways we can strengthen our spiritual foundation during the calm seasons of life?
6. Share about a difficult season (a "storm") in your life. What did that experience reveal about what your life was built on at that time?
7. The crowd was amazed because Jesus "taught with real authority." How does recognizing Jesus' authority change the way we approach His teachings?
8. What does it practically look like to "build your life on Jesus" in these areas:
  - a) Your family relationships?
  - b) Your workplace or school?
  - c) Your financial decisions?
  - d) Your entertainment choices?
  - e) Your response to conflict?
