Sermon Notes January 22, 2023

The Church: Is the Bride of Christ

<u>Big Idea</u> Jesus is coming – I will be ready.

Revelation 19:6-9, Ephesians 5:21-33, Ephesians 1:12-14, John 14:26-29

The Betrothal

This was more than an engagement like we think of today. The betrothal was actually just as binding as being married. The woman who was betrothed to her future husband was bound to her husband. -CL Haynes

The Friend of the Bridegroom

The bridegroom would choose a close and loyal friend whose responsibility was to assit the bride in preparation for the wedding. He would stay by her side throughout this entire betrothal period and make sure she was ready for the bridegroom on the wedding day. -CL Haynes

The Procession

On the day of the wedding, the bridegroom would leave from his father's house and proceed to the house of the father of the bride to receive his bride. The bridegroom would not announce in advance the exact moment when he was coming, so the bride had to be prepared, ready, and waiting for the bridegroom. -CL Haynes

The Ceremony and Feast

Once the bridegroom had received his bride, they would proceed to the house of the father of the bridegroom. They would then have a wedding ceremony followed by a spectacular wedding feast. These feasts could last up to a week and sometimes even longer. -CL Haynes
