Satan's Demonic Devices II Corinthians 2:11, Ephesians 6:10-16

- I. The Definition of Demonic Devices, v. 11
 - wiles Greek "methodeias" schemes, strategies, tricks, cunning devices, methods, deceitful craftiness used by Satan against the child of God.
- II. The Description of Demonic Devices, v. 12, 16
 - they are intentional in design v.11- a process or planned system by which something is accomplished
 - they are intellectual in nature v.12- Satan deceives and distorts by blinding the mind, attacking the intellect.
 - they are intense in activity v.12- Satan aggressively seeks ways to cause us to sin (fiery darts).
 - they are injurious in intent v.12- these fiery darts are meant harm us, hurt us, or bring injury to us in some way.
- III. The Display of Demonic Devices
 - Satan distorts his power
 - by making you think he has little power
 - by making you think he has much power

Satan is not omnipotent, omniscient, or omnipresent.

- Satan destroys your peace
 - by denying our faith
 - by displaying our failings
 - by dimming our future
- Satan delays your pardon
 - by urging us to dismiss our sin
 - by urging us to delay our surrender
