MAIN IDEA.....

Compassion to us should lead to Compassion through us

INTRODUCTION

• Compassion is tied to suffering. Compassion is more than just having pity for someone's suffering. You can have pity with no action. When pity is accompanied with action, it becomes compassion.

DISCUSSION

- What was your "Best Christmas Ever" and what made it so?
- Explain a time when you felt pressured to make Christmas important or meaningful to someone else.
- We talked about how there is a difference between *Looking* at something and *Beholding* something. If you remember this from the sermon, explain what that difference is.
- Have someone read (1 John 3:16-19)
- How do we know what true love is?
- List some practical ways to show love to others through your actions this Christmas.
 - Throughout this next week, concentrate on one of these. Next week share with the group how God was glorified.
- Obviously, Jesus died on the cross for us, but what else could it mean that "Jesus gave up his life for us"?



- Similarly, how can we 'give up our life for others' this Christmas season?
- How would you explain this quote to someone who was not a Christian... "It is impossible to be compassionate and selfish at the same time"?
- We can go through this entire Christmas season either living open-handed or by living with clenched fists. List some ways you can live open-handed towards others.

APPLY IT

- Start with the gospel. If you have not believed in Jesus, do so today. Ask your Life Group to explain the gospel to you.
- Slow Down, stop simply looking at others this Christmas, and start beholding them.
- See Something, Do Something. If you see a need this Christmas, commit to doing something about that need. It doesn't need to be extravagant.
