How Good is Good Enough? Jesus!

INTRODUCTION

• The way we live our lives says much about us. The decisions we make, the paths we choose, each of these speak volumes about our motivations and beliefs. So as Paul defended himself and his message against the accusations of the new teaches in Galatia, he laid his life before his audience. Over and over again he was willing to risk his life, reputation, and even the approval of other Christian leaders to live out the message of grace and freedom he had been given. For us, and for the Galatians, he was an example of someone who lived his life in line with his calling and mission.

DISCUSSION

• Where would your family and friends consider you on the following scale?

Easy Going / Laid Back

Hard-headed / Stubborn

- What are some pros & cons to each?
- Have you ever drastically changed your mind about something (so much so that it surprised others?)
- Have you ever been afraid of the judgement of God? Did the messages you heard at church add to or alleviate that fear?
- Have someone read (Galatians 1:11-17)
 - What do you think it was like for Paul to go from violently opposed to the message of Jesus to arguing with people to accept the message of Jesus?
 - What did he stand to lose or gain in doing so?



"My old self has been crucified with

earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."

- Paul's life had been drastically changed by Jesus... list a few ways Jesus has changed your life?
- God had called Paul to take the message of Jesus to the Gentiles. Do you feel like God has something specific for you to do with your life?
- Have someone read (Galatians 2:1-10)
 - Paul could have compromised his message to gain the approval of others. What are some of the pressures that we face (at work, school, home) that can distract us from following through with what we believe God wants us to do?
 - Paul's life was so completely changed by grace that he could say, as in Galatians 2:20, that Christ lived in and through him. Do you feel like it is Christ living in you, influencing all of your actions and thoughts, or do you find yourself living life on your own?
 - What would be different about this week if you allowed Christ to live through you (to direct you and to guide you in your thoughts and actions)?
- Legalism = The idea that eternal life is obtained by being "Good Enough"
 - How good is good enough?
 - What's your definition of good?
 - Discuss the difference between Effort and Earning. (Lance described the difference as effort is being empowered by God while earning is replacing what only God can provide.
- Series Memory Verse: "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free..." Galatians 5:1

APPLY IT

- Believe who Jesus is and what He has done.
- Believe Jesus will do what He said He will do.
- Depend on Him only.
