All we want to do is get someone's attention. A human. An actual person. "Speak to a Representative. Representative. REPRESENTATIVE. REP-RE-SEN-TA-TIVE."

In prayer, waiting feels like we are dialing the 1-800 number, desperate to get the attention of someone that can actually help us...desperately trying to get God's attention.

But with prayer and waiting, that is simply not the case. We don't pray to get God's attention, we pray because we already have God's attention. So say something! Speak up, and do it often. The ear of the creator of the world is bent towards your voice. It would be a shame to stay silent.
