



We have not loved you with our whole heart. We have not fully loved our neighbors.


We have often taken your gifts for granted. In your mercy, forgive us.



Communion Instruction

Bethany welcomes all to receive the body and blood of Christ in Holy Communion. An usher will direct you forward where you can receive communion by dipping the bread into the wine, or pick up a pre-packaged communion set or a gluten-free communion set from the tray in front of your seating area. Groups are welcome to visit a communion station together. Those who are not receiving communion are invited to cross their arms across their chests to receive a blessing.

This Sacrament is the Gospel: in full measure and beyond all measure. For here in the bread and wine you are given the forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation all at once. (from Large Catechism, Sacrament of the Altar §32)





Available outside the Sanctuary's north doors is a Fidget Station. Children and adults are invited to use these fidgets and art supplies to aid in your spiritual growth and presence in worship.  - ⇒ **Busy Bags:** Near the Sanctuary doors you will find premade bags perfect for littles. Grab one on the way in and return it on the way out.
 - ⇒ **Nursery:** For directions to our Nursery, please speak with an usher. You are welcome to use it with your child.
