-LOVE GOD—LOVE PEOPLE—SERVE THE WORLD-
Ephesians 4:3-6
→God points us to, but He established them to direct us back to Him.
The definition of "baptism" isn't limited to 'water baptism.'
→The words 'baptize' and 'baptism' in Greek come from the Greek word 'baptizo,' which means to immerse, dip, or submerge.
When the Bible discusses baptism, it refers to a person being completely immersed in something.
★Three main types of baptism we see in scripture; Baptism into Christ, Baptism in the, and Baptism in wate
→Water baptism is not salvific; it is
Water baptism is an outward, physical act symbolizing repentance and new life in Christ, and it is performed by as a public declaration of their faith.

+God's grace stands on its own and needs nothing more than the of Jesus to declare a person saved.
+The sacrament of baptism is connected to salvation, but it is not necessary for salvation. Matthew 3:13-17
Water Baptism and Communion are sacraments established by Jesus that believers are to obey and observe, but they are not requirements for salvation. <i>Matthew</i> 28:19-20
2. Baptism of the Spirit occurs when a person accepts Jesus and is thenwith the Holy Spirit. Acts 1:8, 2:4, Eph.1:13-14, 2 Cor.1:22,1 John 2:27
The baptism and indwelling of God's Spirit occurs at salvation, but it is also an ongoing process as we ask God to keep us full and immersed in His Spirit. <i>Ephesians 5:18-20</i>
3. Baptism into Christ occurs when we accept Jesus as our Savior, and we are fully in Him, surrendering all to follow Him. (Salvation, being born again.)
The main thing that unites all believers together in the Spirit is the blessing and gift of Ephesians 1:3-5
1 Corinthians12:12-13
+The "one baptism" in Ephesians 4:5 refers to a single spiritual reality that is in nature. Gal. 3:26-27,Rom. 6:3-4
Answers: sacraments, Spirit, symbolic, believers, blood, water, filled, immersed, salvation, salvific.
