Worldly hope is elusive and a feeling that disappoints, however Biblical hope is a living and sure hope based upon our faith in God.

Jeremiah 29:11, Isaiah 46:9:10

About years after the close of the Old Testament the greatest of all fulfilled prophecies comes to pass; the birth, life, death, and resurrection of the Messiah.
→At least prophecies were fulfilled in the 33 years that Jesus lived.
→Isaiah 9:6,7 is a key scripture that prophesied the birth of Jesus and presents Him as a major source of for all humanity.

Isaiah 9:6,7

→ The Babylonian exile and Romes's occupation were significant in framing the ______ hopes for a Redeemer.

The Messiah was seen by many Jews as a fulfillment of divine promises and a manifestation of God's intervention in human history.

★We have a hope that is found in God, and one way to put our faith in that hope is to know it has a name;
Genuine hope can be found in the various names of Jesus.
→Wonderful : In the original Hebrew, this name can be understood as a "miraculous advisor" or "extraordinary strategist." <i>Jeremiah</i> 29:13
★ God: This title implies strength, power, and sovereignty. It acknowledges Jesus as divine, possessing the power and authority that belong to God. <i>Matthew</i> 28:18
★Everlasting : This title emphasizes Jesus' eternal and paternal care for his followers. It does not imply that Jesus is God the Father, but rather that he possesses qualities of a caring and nurturing father. <i>Matthew 11:28-30, 1 Peter 5:7 AMP</i>
→Prince of: This title signifies Jesus as the one who brings peace, harmony, and reconciliation between God and humanity. Ephesians 2:14
Jesus is the Messiah who has ultimate authority, provides salvation, grace, and guidance to those who follow Him.
Romans 11:13
