LOVE GOD, LOVE PEOPLE, AND SERVE THE WORLD

Worldly hope is elusive and a feeling that disappoints, however Biblical hope is a living and sure hope based upon our faith in God.

**Jeremiah 29:11, Isaiah 46:9:10**

About \_\_\_\_\_ years after the close of the Old Testament the greatest of all fulfilled prophecies comes to pass; *the birth, life, death, and resurrection of the Messiah.*

✦ At least \_\_\_\_\_ prophecies were fulfilled in the 33 years that Jesus lived.

✦ Isaiah 9:6,7 is a key scripture that prophesied the birth of Jesus and presents Him as a major source of \_\_\_\_\_ for all humanity.

**Isaiah 9:6,7**

✦ The Babylonian exile and Rome's occupation were significant in framing the \_\_\_\_\_ hopes for a Redeemer.

The Messiah was seen by many Jews as a fulfillment of divine promises and a manifestation of God's intervention in human history.

✦ We have a hope that is found in God, and one way to put our faith in that hope is to know it has a name; \_\_\_\_\_.

Genuine hope can be found in the various names of Jesus.

✦ **Wonderful** \_\_\_\_\_: In the original Hebrew, this name can be understood as a "miraculous advisor" or "extraordinary strategist." **Jeremiah 29:13**

✦ \_\_\_\_\_ **God**: This title implies strength, power, and sovereignty. It acknowledges Jesus as divine, possessing the power and authority that belong to God. **Matthew 28:18**

✦ **Everlasting** \_\_\_\_\_: This title emphasizes Jesus' eternal and paternal care for his followers. It does not imply that Jesus is God the Father, but rather that he possesses qualities of a caring and nurturing father. **Matthew 11:28-30, 1 Peter 5:7 AMP**

✦ **Prince of** \_\_\_\_\_: This title signifies Jesus as the one who brings peace, harmony, and reconciliation between God and humanity. **Ephesians 2:14**

Jesus is the Messiah who has ultimate authority, provides salvation, grace, and guidance to those who follow Him.

**Romans 11:13**
