- 3. Nations aligning together against Israel. *Ezekiel 38. 39*.
- 4. Increased earthquakes, famines, and pestilences. Matthew 24, Mark 13, Luke 21.
- 5. Increase in travel and knowledge. Daniel 12:4

→ With the rise of \_\_\_\_ and its use to deceive, we must know our Bible, understand the Gospel, and be more vigilant than ever before.
