- → Jesus talked a lot about believers being _____, and how He is the Great Shepherd.
- →Sheep need a shepherd because:
 - 1. They are not very smart when left to their own devices.
 - 2. They are directionless and are prone to wander. Isaiah 53:6
 - 3. They are defenseless. Psalms 23:1-4
- ♦ We must ourselves and admit what is true about us and elevate God by declaring what is true of Him.

John 10:1-10

- ♦ Verse 10 speaks of three types of people:
 - 1. Those that believe there is more than one Gate to get to God.
 - 2. Those that teach that you can get to God apart from THE Gate, Jesus Christ.
 - 3. Those that deny their need for a shepherd.

When Jesus said, "I AM the gate for the sheep," he was calling out all those who claimed to be "gatekeepers" for access to God.

→The main purpose of God giving the Israelites His law was to point them to the coming
Galatians 3:23-26, Ecclesiastes 7:20, Romans 3:23
+God's law makes our evident, and our need for a Savior a necessity.
Romans 7:7
✦God gave the Law to sin and demonstrate our desperate need for a Savior.
2 Corinthians 5:17
♣As Christians, we can now say that we are no longer, but children of God that sometimes sin, or as the Bible says; "miss the mark."
Jesus exposed the ways the religious leaders had replaced their calling to bring light to the world with these HIGH religious walls that kept all "sinners" away.
◆There are three functions of a gate:
 Protection and safety. 2. Entrance and opportunity. Signifies home and belonging.

opportunity, that speaks of home and for eternity.
