Ephesians 4:3-6

Hebrews 11:1

James 2:14-26

◆Three kinds of faith that James describes in chapter 2 are:
1. faith.
→Our faith in God is inoperative and if it is not displayed in the way we live.
→Our belief should inspire action thatour faith!
2. faith.
→ Just believing that there is a God with no is just as delusional as not believing in Him at all.
Christians who say they believe in God but go out and deny Him by their lifestyle, is what an unbelieving world finds so unbelievable.
3. faith.
→ James tells us that dynamic faith is faith that's real, faith that has power, faith that results in a life.
There's no conflict between faith and works because the "one faith" that unites believers is a faith that works.
Answers: divine, Dead, ineffective, reflects, Delusional, action, Dynamic, changed.
