While naming is tied to authority in the scriptures, it also reveals Exodus 3:13-15
In the New Testament "I AM" is translated from the Greek word ""
→God's name "I AM" is rendered as in Hebrew.
Israel's history shows us that the name Yahweh was considered too holy to even pronounce, so "God" was simply referred to as "The Name" or in Hebrew they say ""
→Some English translations of the Bible usually render Yahweh as "," in all caps.
"I AM" denotes action as the "," the One for whom there is no prior cause, the One who makes things happen according to our deepest needs.

→God is saying "" whatever humanity needs me to be at the time.

+"I AM" means; "Yahweh" and, it reveals four very important things about God:
