Love prompts trust, forgiveness, and
Trust is not dictated only by the trustworthiness of another person. It comes from what you know and how you arrange what you know into a representation or "trust picture" of that person. HOW TO BUILD AND REBUILD TRUST.
1. Keep "Speak the truth in love." Eph. 4:15
2. Cultivate openness. Mutuality is vital to building trust.
3. Be willing to and let go. Ephesians 4:31-32 "Holding a grudge is like drinking poison and then hoping the `other person dies!"
4. Recognize thebetween forgiveness and trust. Forgiveness, by nature cannot be earned; it can only be given. Trust, by nature, should be given only as it is earned.
5. Be willing tosome of your relationship rules. Set boundaries in the relationship, increase transparency, and alter some agreed-upon rules.
6. Be willing totrust. Trust will never develop in your relationship unless trust is both earned and given.
7. Don't give up! Don't quit when it gets hard! Keep loving each other and allow God to bring wholeness and healing to your relationship.
Answers: involved, confidence, think, accurate, discernment, healing, communicating, mutual, forgive difference, change, give.
