Eschatology: the theology dealing with the final events of history, or the ultimate destiny of humanity.

- +The end times message should never make Christians fearful, but cheerful.
- +Since the return of Christ is imminent, and accepting Jesus is what makes things permanent, preaching on the end times is ever so appropriate.
- +All preaching should be laced with love, especially when preaching on the end times.

★The first thing that every Christian should know is:

The Bible is the inspired Word of God

- ★The Bible is scientific, archaeological, historical, prophetic, and gives us the answers to life, and death.
- +Rather than fighting a fight of fear, we learn to fight from the front of faith.
- +If you cannot accept the Bible as the inspired living word of God, then you will be lost in a dead end round about with no answers to your dilemmas.

Isaiah 46:9-10

+There are two Greek words in the New Testament that describe Scripture, these are Logos and Rhema.

Logos refers to Jesus and the total inspired Word of God.

Rhema is translated as an utterance, or the "Spoken Word"

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.
