

December 12th , 2021— "Abiding Joy" LOVE GOD, LOVE PEOPLE, AND SERVE THE WORLD

Psalms 30:5 Weeping may last through the night, but joy comes with the morning.

True Joy is not based upon things or circumstance. It is based upon our relationship with Jesus.

Psalms 42:4

- + Joy is an **inner** feeling. Happiness is an **outward** expression.
- +A person **pursues** happiness but **chooses** joy.
- "There are moments when I wish I could roll back the clock and take all the sadness away, but I have the feeling that if I did, the joy would be gone as well." ~Nicholas Sparks
- +Joy comes from the Holy Spirit, abiding in God's presence and from hope in His Word.
- +God's Joy is not based on material circumstances, but instead is based on His presence in our lives.

1. Joy is a gift of the Holy Spirit.

2. Joy is uncontainable.
