Ephesians 4:3-6

Not everyone recognizes God as a Father, nor is everyone under His Lordship, so theologically speaking, God does not dwell in and through all.

- +Sin separated God's Fatherhood into two different categories.
- 1. God the Father in the sense that he is God.
- **2.** God the Father in the sense that He is God.
