out of surrender.**

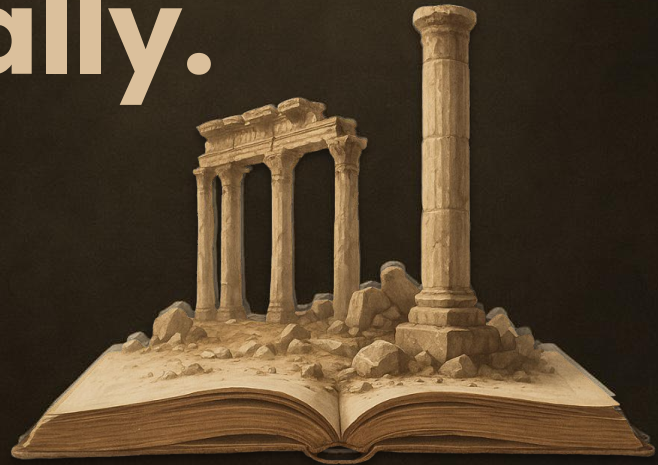




# PAUL'S PRAYER TEACHES US..

with them naturally.**



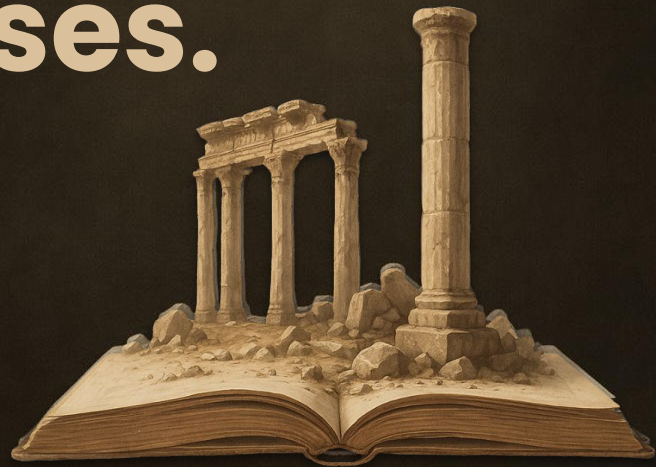
## Eph 6:15 CSB

“Pray also for me, that the message may be given to me when I open my mouth to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel.”

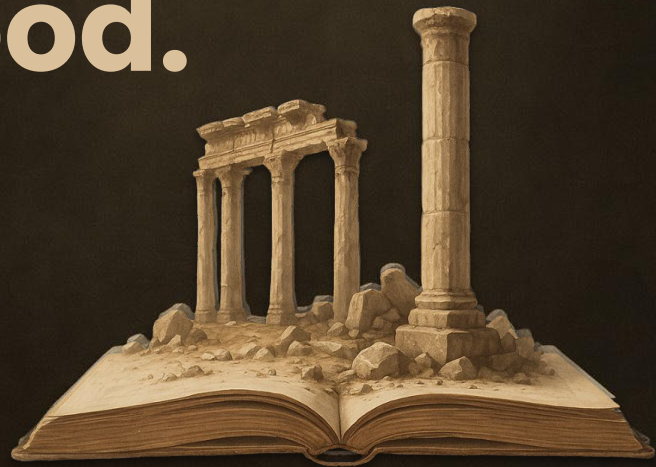




**When we pray it
