

Jonathan said to David, “Go in peace, for the two of us have sworn in the name of the LORD, saying, ‘May the LORD





descendants and mine forever.”




## 2 Sam 9:7

“But the plans of the LORD stand firm forever, the purposes of His heart through all generations.”




God's sovereignty is
