




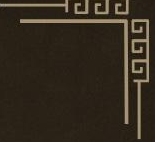

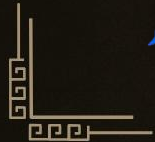

**Effective servants must readily admit their need for God's intervention through intercession.**



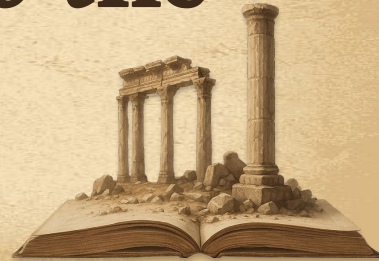

**“Then an angel appeared to Him from heaven, strengthening Him. 44 And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly.”**



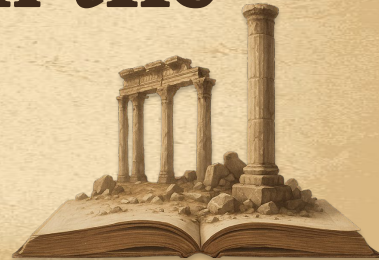
## Philippians 1:12-14

and to all the rest, that my chains are in Christ; 14 and most of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.

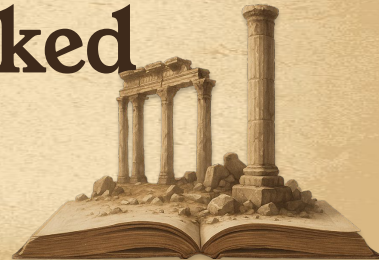


**Prayer is the means
