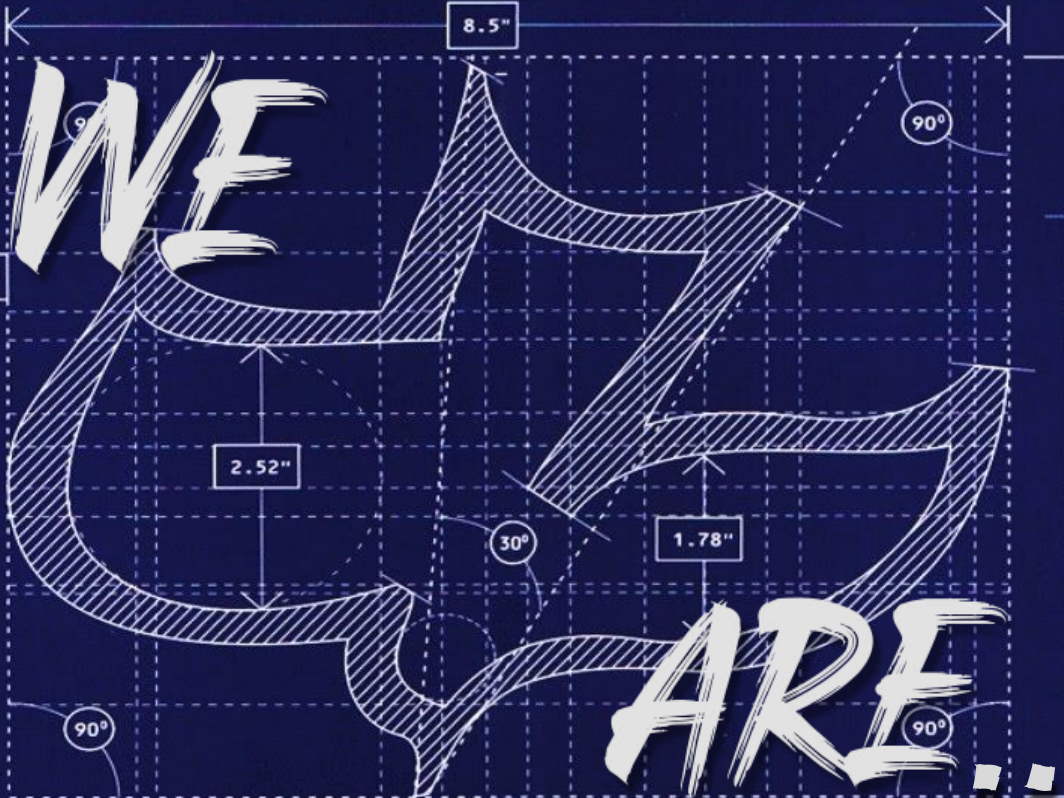

DESCRIPTION OF BOVE LOGO: Created originally for Aracacha! Evangelical Association in the early years of the Jesus Movement, the "Calvary Chapel Dove" eventually became one of the endorsing icons associated with Calvary Chapel. For 30 years this symbol, mounted on the exterior of Calvary Chapel of Costa Mesa, has been a reminder that the Holy Spirit working in and through the fellowship is solely responsible for the amazing spread of the gospel both nationally and worldwide.

DESCRIPTION OF DOVE LOGO: Created originally for Parakletos! Evangelical Association in the early years of the Jesus Movement, the dove logo was used to symbolize the Holy Spirit. It was later adopted by Calvary Chapel, for its emphasis on the Holy Spirit. The logo has been a reminder that the Holy Spirit is the one who is solely responsible for the spreading of the gospel both nationally and worldwide.
