Getting Started Questions (choose 1 or 2 to discuss):

1. What song will you never forget the lyrics to?
2. If you could completely get rid of one month out of the year, which month would it be and why?
3. What is your favorite fall activity?
4. What word(s) do you always mispronounce?

Personal Growth:

5. What is something that you learned in your personal devotional time this past week?
6. What is something God is teaching you in this season of your life (everyone share)?

Message Review:

7. What were some other discoveries you made this past week about the role that fear plays in your life?
8. What were some other discoveries you made this past week about how you trust God?
9. What steps did you take this past week to develop your trust in God?

Message Discussion:

10. How did David know that God was with Him?
11. How do you know that God is with you?
12. Read **Hebrews 11:6** aloud in group and answer the following questions:
 - a. How might the faith steps that God is calling you to reinforce that God is with you?
 - b. Why does every faith step require God to be a part of it?
13. What did David find on the other side of His faith steps?

Take Home:

14. What is one truth that you learned this week that will help animate your next faith step?
15. **Personal Faith Step Process:**
 - a. Dedicate 10 – 15 minutes tomorrow to seeking God, asking Him what your next faith step is.
 - b. Write that faith step down somewhere you can revisit it later.
 - c. Take that faith step.
 - d. Be prepared next week to discuss how your faith step process went.

Leader Take:

- Prior to group, take some time to re-read 1 Samuel 17:1-50 and pray that God would reveal truths to you that you could encourage your group with this week.
- Please dedicate some time before group to read through the questions so that you have a clear direction of where to lead the discussion.
- Check in with each group member 2-3 days after your group meets and see how their “take home” is coming along.
