DISCUSSION QUESTIONS | MARCH 8TH

1. In Matthew 9:35, Jesus is described as teaching, proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing. What do these three activities show us about how Jesus lived on mission?
2. Verse 36 says Jesus saw the crowds and had compassion on them because they were “harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.” What do those descriptions reveal about how Jesus saw people?
3. In verses 37–38, Jesus tells His disciples that the harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few. According to Jesus, what is the first response to the need around us? Why do you think He tells them to pray before anything else?
4. Jon challenged us to see people the way Jesus sees them. When you think about the people around you (family, friends, neighbors, coworkers etc) - who comes to mind as someone the Lord may be inviting you to notice/invest in more intentionally?
5. Who's on your BLESS radar? What is one simple step you could take this week to move toward someone who may be far from God?
