DISCUSSION QUESTIONS | JUNE 28TH

1. What was something that stood out to you - encouraging, challenging, refreshing, etc. - about gathering with the people of God today? An interaction, part of the sermon, song, etc.?
2. Throughout Ecclesiastes 4, Solomon exposes the places we instinctively look when life feels broken. Which of the four observations hit you the hardest this week (power, achievement, success, or recognition)? Why do you think that one resonated with you?
3. One of the surprising movements in the chapter is from "they had no comforter" (v. 1) to the picture of people helping one another in verses 9-12. Who has been that kind of person in your life? And how is God calling you to become that kind of person for someone else?
4. Ecclesiastes ends by telling us to "remember your Creator." What would it look like this week to stop asking one created thing to do the work of your Creator? Is there one practical step you could take to put that into practice?
