1. What strengthened, encouraged, or convicted you from God's Word or being with God's people this past week?
2. Looking at verses 1-3, what are the specific ways the Shepherd cares for, leads, and provides for His sheep? What do these images teach us about God's character?
3. What do you think Psalm 23 reveals about the kind of person David had become through years of walking with the Lord? What kind of trust or maturity do you see in him?
4. David doesn't say, "The Lord is a shepherd," but "The Lord is my shepherd." What's the difference? What does that personal language reveal about the kind of relationship David has with God?
5. Psalm 23 ends with confidence that "goodness and mercy shall follow me." Do you tend to believe God is moving toward you in mercy or disappointment? Why?
