## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS | MARCH 22ND

1. What is one thing from the sermon that you found encouraging, challenging, or personally convicting? Why did that stand out to you?
2. What tends to hold you back most from sharing your faith (fear, busyness, not knowing what to say, past experiences, etc.)? And How does this passage begin to reshape or challenge that barrier?
3. Can you share a time when someone spoke to you about Jesus or influenced your faith? What made that interaction meaningful (or not)?
4. Colossians emphasizes that God is the one opening doors, not us. Practically speaking, do you live like evangelism depends more on your ability or God's activity? Explain.
5. Paul describes evangelism as "answering each person," not delivering a script. When conversations turn towards spiritual things, do you tend to listen well or move quickly to speak? What are some simple, thoughtful questions you could ask that help you better understand someone's story, struggles, or beliefs?
