## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS | APRIL 5TH

1. What is one thing from the sermon that you found encouraging, challenging, or personally convicting? Why did that stand out to you?
2. In 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, Paul summarizes the gospel he preached. What are the core elements of the gospel according to this passage, and why does Paul emphasize that it is “of first importance”?
3. In verses 12-14, Paul says if Christ has not been raised, our preaching and faith are in vain. According to the text, why is the resurrection so essential to the Christian faith?
4. How does believing that your future is a real, physical resurrection (not just “going to heaven”) reshape the way you think about your body, your suffering, and your everyday life right now? (Think v. 58).
5. Where do you most need the hope of the resurrection right now - and how might remembering that Christ is risen actually change your perspective this week?
