1. What has been your most encouraging, challenging, etc. thing that you've gained from Ecclesiastes this Summer?
2. Ecclesiastes 12:1 begins, "Remember also your Creator in the days of your youth." What do you think the Teacher means by "remember"? How is it different from simply believing that God exists?
3. In verses 1- 8, the Teacher vividly describes the realities of aging and death. Why do you think he spends so much time reminding us of life's brevity? What is he hoping his readers will do in response?
4. Has there been a time in your life where you felt like the Lord (the One Shepherd) has not remembered you?
5. Ecclesiastes ends by pointing us to the One who gives lasting meaning beyond life "under the sun." How does knowing Jesus, who conquered death and offers eternal life, change the way we view aging, purpose, and the everyday moments of life?
