### **Memory Verse:**

**Hebrews 1:3 CSB**

**3 The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact expression of his nature, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.**

The research revealed that:

- loneliness dropped 30%
- anger issues dropped 32%
- bitterness in relationships dropped 40%
- alcohol consumption dropped 57%
- feeling spiritually stagnant dropped 60%
- viewing pornography dropped 60%
- sharing your faith increased 20%
- commitment to discipling other believers jumped 200%
