



## Jesus Is Greater - Jesus the Greater Way Hebrews 10:19–39

Is trust a rare commodity? Why or why not?

### Memory Verse:

**Hebrews 10:22 NLT**

**Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise.**

**Read: Hebrews 10:19-25, Hebrews 4:16, Romans 5:8**

The command to approach the throne of grace with confidence and boldness is repeated in the Book of Hebrews. Why do you think this was necessary?

What keeps us from approaching the throne with confidence and boldness today?

Romans 5:8 usually has one of two effects on a person; either they are humbled by God's grace and love and draw closer to Him, or they identify with shame because of their sin and downplay God's love and grace for them. What could these two reactions reveal about their hearts?

If you were able to have an honest conversation with them, what would you caution or encourage about these reactions.

How would you explain entering into God's presence with confidence and boldness, but also with reverence when you do?

How has going to church, or even being part of this group motivated you to love and good works?

What difference has making church a priority made in your Christian walk?

What does it mean to you that you make an impact on other believers, for good or for bad?

**Read: Hebrews 10:26-31, Matthew 7:21-23, 1 John 5:13, Acts 17:30, Mark 1:15**

This is a hotly contested scripture. Some passages seem to indicate that you cannot lose your salvation, this one seems to indicate that you can. The debate is often ultimately unfruitful, the final point that matters is, are you truly saved?

Since it is possible that we could get this wrong, how do you know that you are saved?

How would you know if you had a false repentance or salvation?

What does it mean to believe the Good News?

Discuss the three fold role of Jesus as Forgiver, Savior, and Lord. Do we need to commit to submitting to Him as all three?

**Read: Hebrews 10:32-39**

What does faithfulness look like for you in this season of life? What might it look like in the future?

Scripture tells us Jesus is coming back, and that we who are faithful to the end have a great promise awaiting. How do we maintain our commitment to Him in the mean time?
