



Simple Christmas - Simple Solution

Imagine that you have the ability to buy someone a Christmas gift that would help them understand the Gospel. What would that gift be? (No you can't say the Bible, and no repeats!)

Memory Verse:

Matthew 1:21 NKJV

And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.

We were made by Him, for Him, and our highest joy and sense of satisfaction comes from Him, but our sin separates us from Him. How does sin affect our walk with Christ?

For every mile of road there is two miles of ditch. Do we take sin seriously enough, or are we too serious about our sin? How do we find the balance?

Read: Genesis 3:14-15, Genesis 12:1-3

These promises both speak to the coming Messiah, apart from God's promise to send Him, what do these verses reveal about the character of God? What brings you comfort or hope?

God gives us a purpose in His promise, to be great, to be a blessing, to walk on earth as His beloved. What are the biggest challenges people face in walking in that purpose?

How do we grow in walking in that purpose and promise without missing the mark?

Read: Romans 1:18-23, Galatians 3:19-24, Romans 8:7-9, 1 John 2:6

If we don't see the severity of our sin we never know the necessity of a Savior. What have you read lately in the Word that has caused you to draw closer to Jesus?

The severity of our sin is measured against His perfection, and we don't even come close.

If we are saved in the moment of our faith, is it important to keep living according to the Law? Why or Why not?

Mark 1:15 NLT

"The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!"

What does it mean to "repent and believe" the Good News? How would you describe that to someone you want to reach?
