Read: Hebrews 9:15-10:18

Read: Genesis 2:15-17, Romans 6:23, Isaiah 59:2, Leviticus 17:11

Read: Joshua 24:15, Romans 10:9, Acts 16:30-31, Deuteronomy 30:19, Revelation 3:20

If Jesus paid the price once and for all, why do we have to choose Him every single day?

Why were the sacrifices of the old covenant insufficient? (Hebrews 10:1-4)

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:21, Philippians 1:6
