Memory Verse:

Hebrews 7:22 NIV - “Because of this oath, Jesus has become the guarantor of a better covenant.”

What does it look like for Jesus to be the guarantor of a better Covenant? How is the New Covenant better than any of the other Covenants God made?

Read Hebrews 7:1-10

Melchizedek was a type of Christ in many ways. Not only did his name, his role as king of Salem, and his office as High Priest of God the Most High prefigure Jesus, but so does the mystery that surrounds the rest of his life. Why do you think God uses Typology in the Bible?

What other characters in the Bible are a “type of Christ”?

Read: Philippians 3:8-11

Does it sound like Paul believes works based faith (earning your salvation), or does it sound like he believes in being saved by grace through faith? Why is it important to not read scripture in a vacuum, and to study beyond what one or two verses in any passage may say?

Read: Hebrews 7:23-28

Does the weight of being completely saved by the Blood of Jesus move you when you think about it? Does knowing that you are under the New Covenant motivate you to live in a certain way?

How can you describe the greatness of the New Covenant to someone who is not saved?

Take time to pray for each other, and come up with ways that you can share the freedom and the greatness of the New Covenant with unbelievers this week!
