



## **Follow Me - Last Hope for the End Times**

### **Memory Verse:**

#### **Mark 13:35-36 NKJV**

**35 Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming—in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the morning— 36 lest, coming suddenly, he find you sleeping.**

OK it's the end of the world as we know it... You can take 1 person, 1 tool, and one book (other than the Bible of course you have probably already memorized it anyway!) What are you bringing with you and why?

### **Read Mark 13**

The Jews of the day were looking for signs that the end would come, and while Jesus did give them signs, more than that, He showed them the Way. How much time should we give to looking for signs?

Jesus warned multiple times about being deceived. Have you ever been deceived? If so, what happened, and how did it happen? What could you have done differently?

When it comes to the end times, at LifePoint we are committed to being ready and on mission. How might fear of the end times cause us to fall into mission drift and fail to live up to our purpose?

How might disregarding these signs Jesus warns us about cause us to fall into complacency in the times we are needed the most?

## **Becoming Foolproof**

As you read the verses below, what do they tell us about Jesus, and Holy Spirit?

**Read: 2 Corinthians 11:3-4, 13-15, Mark 10:45, Luke 5:31-32, John 3:16, John 16:8, John 15:26, Galatians 5:16-18, Philippians 1:6, Godly Wisdom 1 Corinthians 2:10-13**

How might a false Christ represent himself?

What might clue you into if you are being tempted or led by a false Spirit?

**Read: Ephesians 2:8-9, 1 Corinthians 15:1-4**

There will also be a Different Gospel:

- Social Gospel - Tied to social movements rather than Jesus.
- Prosperity Gospel - Tied to God serving us, rather than us serving Him.
- Cheap Gospel - Makes light of sin and diminishes Christ's work on the Cross.
- Works Based Gospel - Allows us to save ourselves.

What is dangerous about these false gospels?

If you had to tell someone what the Gospel really is, what would you say?

There are two responses to the gospel: faith and obedience. How has believing in the Gospel increased your faith and led to more obedience?

**Read: 2 Thessalonians 2:9-10, John 14:6**
