#### Read: Romans 6:23, Ecclesiastes 3:11, Revelation 20:14

How do you describe eternity?

There are 3 main views on the Rapture:

- -Pre-tribulation Rapture Christ comes for the church before it all goes down.
- Mid-tribulation Rapture Christ comes for the church halfway through.
- Post-tribulation Christians will go through the entirety of the Great Tribulation and will be taken up immediately before the second coming.

Which one do you like the most? What could happen to someone's faith if it didn't play out as they expected?

Read: Revelation 1:3, Revelation 1:7, 2 Corinthians 5:10, Revelation 21:6-8, Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8, Mark 1:17

What do these passages have to do with the end times?

The central call of the Christian life is evangelism, it is about doing all we can to help other people come to know Jesus and celebrate Him forever in Heaven.
