How do you normally respond in fearful situations?

Memory Verse:

**The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom should I fear?
The Lord is the stronghold of my life—whom should I dread?**

Psalms 27:1

Why is the word MY so important in this verse?

Read: Psalm 27

How does David overcome his fear and remain confident in God, despite his circumstances?

What does it mean to 'seek God's face' (v8) and why was it so important for David (and us!) to want to 'dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of his life' (v4)?

Considering v9, have you ever felt like God has forsaken you and isn't answering your prayers/ how did you respond? What can we learn from David's response here?

What does this psalm tell us about God's character?

Waiting is often one of the hardest things God asks us to do; Why is waiting so difficult for us? Why is waiting beneficial for us?

Read: Revelation 2:1-7

How are we similar to the church in Ephesus?

What is God saying must be first in our lives?

Brian listed off three ways to grow in intimacy with God; Which of the three is the hardest to do? Which one do you excel at?

1. Devote time to spend with Him
2. Don't come with an agenda or a timeline
3. He has Prepared the table, Go dine with Him!

What are the greatest fears in your life currently? How will you face those fears differently after reflecting on this psalm?
