Memory Verse:

Hebrews 3:1

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession. Hebrews 3:1

READ: Hebrews 3:1-6

In this passage the writer was addressing the people about making Moses an idol in their lives. In today's world we probably don't make Moses an idol but we do place other things as idols over Jesus.

Read: Verse 3 again
