So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son.

Read: Luke 1:5-38, Matthew 1:18-25, Luke 2:8-20

This morning in the message Pastor Kelly said, *"If you knew what God sees in you, and believed what He says about you, you would be an unstoppable force upon the earth."*

How do we know what God thinks about us? Why is it so easy that He doesn't see us in a positive light?

Zechariah doubted that God was going to do what the angel said He was going to do. What is something you are believing God for right now that hasn't happened yet? How do we cultivate trust to help us get through while we wait for it to come to pass?

Mary's answer in Luke 1:38 was both humble and confident. Do we need both of these characteristics to be used powerfully by God? Why or why not?

Shepherds were not seen with much positive regard in their community, and yet God chose them to have an angelic concert and to be among the first to welcome the young Messiah. God often follows this pattern of using those who society would look over. Why do you feel He does that?

What if we are the angels of someone else's story? What could that look like for us?

But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have.

What does it look like to “always be prepared to give an answer”?

How do you prepare yourself for this call to go tell the world about Jesus?
