# **The Name You Can't Stop Saying**

**Scripture Reading:** Psalm 150:1–6 (NKJV)

## **Main Thought**

Every breath is a gift from God, and every breath is meant to return praise to the One who gave it.

## **Key Scriptures**

Genesis 2:7; Psalm 150:1–6; Acts 17:25; Philippians 2:9–11; Romans 10:13

## **Point 1 – Every Breath Comes From God**

God breathed life into Adam. The breath in our lungs is not self-produced but a continual gift from our Creator.

## **Point 2 – Every Breath Has a Purpose**

Psalm 150 ends by declaring that everything with breath should praise the Lord. Worship is our natural response to God's gift of life.

## **Point 3 – The Name Above Every Name**

If Jesus has saved us, His name should be the most familiar name on our lips—in worship, in trials, in gratitude, and in witness.

## **Application**

- What name fills my conversations most?
- Does my praise extend beyond Sunday?
- Am I using the breath God gave me to glorify Him?

## **Closing Challenge**

As long as God gives you breath, let the name of Jesus be the name you can't stop saying.
