KEY SCRIPTURE

"For they hear your words, but they do not do them."

Ezekiel 33:32 NKJV

1 They Came to Hear, but Not to Change

We can sit before God's Word with our bodies present while our hearts have already decided not to surrender. What truth is God asking me to receive - not merely evaluate?

A truth I need to act on:

2 They Mistook Emotion for Transformation

Being moved isn't the same as being changed. Real encounters with Jesus change our direction. Where have I felt conviction without following it with obedience?

One change that would show genuine transformation:

3 They Wanted God's Words Without God's Authority

We can't call Jesus Lord while continually reserving the right to tell Him no. What part of my life have I kept outside Christ's authority?

Today I need to surrender:

4 The Most Dangerous Word Is 'Later'

Delayed obedience keeps producing the same result as disobedience. The moment to respond to God is now. What have I been postponing that God has already made clear?

My first step of obedience will be:

THE QUESTION ISN'T WHETHER I HEARD HIM.

What am I going to do now?

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HEAR IT. RECEIVE IT. LIVE IT.
