LESSONS ON DEVOTION
FROM RUTH

In her own life, Sinach admitted, “I felt I was like a fish out of water because I was going to a kind of area where I haven’t been before,” she recalled. “And the Lord was pulling me in that area.” Yet in her uncertainty, she chose to hold on to the Lord, seeking Him and resting in His faithfulness. As a result of this experience, she penned the song Way Maker. In the bridge, she wrote: “Even when I don’t see it, You’re working. Even when I don’t feel it, You’re working. You never stop, You never stop working.” In this week’s study, we look at the life of Ruth, a Gentile who had come to know the living God and, in her devotion to Him, desired to follow Him wherever He led, even when the future seemed unclear! Through Ruth’s faith in God and her faithfulness to Him, we can be inspired to live a life that is fully devoted to Him as we serve Him in all aspects of our lives, even when we may not always see what He is doing!!
