DIG DEEPER

“The less we depend on ourselves, the more dependable we find God to be.” - Hudson Taylor

Read 2 Corinthians 12:9-10

Paul talks about God’s power being made perfect in weakness. How does that challenge the way we normally think about strength and confidence?

(We tend to think strength means having it all together. Scripture teaches that true strength is dependence on God.)

(Open for discussion)

DIG DEEPER

“Courage is not the absence of fear, but the decision that something else is more important than fear.” Franklin D. Roosevelt

Read James 1:22–25

James challenges us not just to hear the Word, but to do it. Why is it easier to hear truth than to actually live it out?

(Open for discussion. Knowledge is easier than obedience because it doesn’t require change. Obedience requires surrender, humility, and often stepping into discomfort. It’s one thing to understand truth—it’s another to actually live it out when it costs you something.)

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
