
Who preached the gospel to the Corinthians?

Why is it important to “hold fast to the word”?

Why did Paul pass on what he had received?

Because this message of the gospel was the most important thing that he could pass on.

What are the main tenets of the gospel found in verses 3 and 4 of 1 Corinthians 15? Why are these important?

That Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,
