### DISCUSS

How was Jesus ultimately vindicated by the Father (Rom 1:3-4; 1 Tim 3:16)?

#### **APPLY**

The Lord's servant will "sustain with a word him who is weary" (v. 4). What words or promises of Jesus sustain you in your times of need?

If Christ willingly subjected his back, cheeks, and face to disgrace for you, is there anything you're unwilling to endure for him?

How can you hope in God's sovereign power to vindicate you when wrongly accused or mistreated (Pr 20:22; Rom 12:19; 1 Pet 2:23)?

#### COMMIT

Think of a situation in your life where you have or might suffer unjustly. Commit this situation to the Lord and think about how you can respond as Jesus would.
