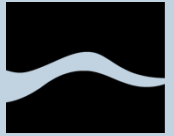


SERMON NOTES

TELL ME ABOUT HIS SUPREME WORTH

Mark 14:1-11



BIG IDEA: Every response to Jesus reveals what we believe he is really worth.

APPLICATION GUIDE

JULY 12, 2026

DISCUSS

What is something you own—or someone in your life—that you would never willingly give up? What makes it so valuable to you?

Our answers reveal what we value most. In Mark 14, every person in the story reveals what they believe Jesus is worth.

EXPLORE

Mark intentionally places the woman's anointing between the religious leaders' plot and Judas' betrayal. What contrasts do you see between these three responses to Jesus? What do those responses reveal about each person's heart?

Why did Jesus call Mary's act "a beautiful thing" when others viewed it as a waste? What did Mary understand about Jesus that the others missed?

How does this passage reveal both God's sovereignty and human responsibility in the events leading to Jesus' crucifixion?

APPLY

Is there anything in your life that Jesus is asking you to surrender but that you've been holding onto because you value it more than obedience to Him?

Mary gave Jesus her very best. What would it look like for you to express that same kind of wholehearted devotion in this season of your life?

Judas traded Jesus for something temporary. What modern-day "thirty pieces of silver" might tempt you to trade obedience to Christ for?

COMMIT

This week, I will identify one area of my life where I need to value Jesus more than something else, and I will take one concrete step of obedience to demonstrate that He is my greatest treasure.
