- 5. You harvest as you **take every opportunity** God provides for you to plant.

Which phrase describes you most right now (weary *in* the work, weary *of* the work)? What needs to happen to help you work and wait with greater joy and energy?

What opportunities for spiritual planting is God providing for you right now? What initial steps can you take to prepare the ground, plant the seeds, and care for its growth while you wait?

Identify one unbeliever and one believer that you can do good to as a means of sowing to the Spirit for harvest in their life and yours.
